| Advanced Placement (AP)                  | <p>Scores must be sent to Virginia Tech from <a href="#">CollegeBoard</a> by entering Virginia Tech's School Code #5859. They will submit them electronically.</p> <p><b>Transfer students must also submit AP scores from <a href="#">CollegeBoard</a> as your prior institution(s) transcript will not include those scores.</b></p> <p>*A maximum of 38 credits can be awarded.<br/>*Student score report copies will not be accepted.</p>   |
| College Level Examination Program (CLEP) | <p>Scores must be sent to Virginia Tech from <a href="#">CollegeBoard</a> by entering Virginia Tech's School Code #5859. They will submit them electronically.</p>  |
| Dual Enrollment (DE) /Transfer           | <p>Official transcripts for dual enrollment courses or courses taken at other universities must be submitted to Virginia Tech. <b>Your high school does not send dual enrollment credits and you MUST request</b> an official transcript from the university the courses were taken.</p> <p>You can request the official transcripts from most university websites and have them sent electronically to Virginia Tech and have them emailed to <a href="mailto:admissions@vt.edu">admissions@vt.edu</a>.</p> <p><b>If you are unable to submit the official transcript in an electronic format, please have the official transcript mailed to:</b><br/>Office of Undergraduate Admissions<br/>Virginia Tech<br/>925 Prices Fork Road<br/>Blacksburg, VA 24061</p> |
